He also stated according to the Town's zoning this parcel would not allow a conditional use permit and would put the Town in a vulnerable position.

Ken Weyenberg, resident at 1742 Quarry Park Drive, stated he was opposed to the batch plant because the same reasons as indicated by Tom Gorzlancyk.

<u>Greg Little, resident at 2816 Freedom Road</u>, stated he is in favor of the permit because they provide additional revenue for the Town through water purchases and these types of customers help keep the rates lower for all residents.

No other comments were received.
