We are expecting the chassis to be available in February 2024, with the buildout in March or April. There has been some difficulty getting the truck to date due to supply chain factors. Though we kept our spot in line, the downside is that an additional model year and emissions year have passed which increases the cost. There will be further updates and considerations at a future Town Board meeting.
