Houses removed from their original foundations for the purpose of moving to a new location shall be either removed from the Town or transported to a permanent location in the Town within 24 hours of removal from the original foundation. In the event the new permanent location is within the Town, the house in transport shall be secured on a permanent foundation at the new location within 30 days from the time the house was moved to the permanent location.

1. NO BURNING or BURIAL of building waste material is allowed in the Town without DNR and local fire chief approval. Waste materials are to be removed and disposed of at a site certified to receive them according to DNR and State requirements.
2. Owners are advised of the WDNR Ch. NR447 concerning control of asbestos emissions and possible need for DNR notification requirements. Your site may require you to have an asbestos inspection. This is not conducted by the local building inspector. For more information contact the DNR.
3. Warning tape or fences will be installed to alert the public of a hazard condition until such hazard is removed.
4. Electric and gas utilities must be notified to remove or seal services at entry points to the demolished building.
5. Digger's Hot line must be notified whenever any excavation is conducted.
6. All underground tanks must be removed from property subject to DNR or State requirements.
7. Documentation must be provided showing removal or abandonment of private septic systems.
8. Wells must be abandoned according to Town of Lawrence ordinance.
9. Foundation holes must be immediately filled and brought to grade levels that prevent standing water or other hazards to the public.
10. Erosion control must remain until site vegetation is stabilized.
